Freedom: God's Presence Revives Us Exodus 13 5-17-20

I. Becoming Free in Daily Life is not a Straight Line. (Exodus 13:17)

II. God Given Detours Strengthen our Freedom. (Exodus 13:17-18)

"Wilderness Experiences" – Desolate places God orchestrates for us to experience Godly brokenness and a deeper walk with God

2 Corinthians 1:9 – "...(our trouble) was to make us rely not on ourselves but on God who raises the dead."

III. God's Manifest Presence Moves us to Greater Freedom. (Exodus 13:19-14:14)

Psalm 119:25 – "My soul clings to the dust; give me life according to your word!"

Psalm 80:18 – "Then we shall not turn back from you; give us life, and we will call upon your name!"

Psalm 85:6 – "Will you not revive us again, that your people may rejoice in you?"

Mark 3:27 – "Jesus said, 'No one can enter a strong man's house and plunder his goods, unless he first binds the strong man. Then indeed he may plunder his house."
