Transformation Scripture Jesus said, "...apart from Me you can do nothing." John 15:5

Monday, 5-6-13 - Reflecting on Yesterday

- 1. Read Philippians 1: 27-30. Discuss Sunday's message with someone.
- 2. Read 1 Peter 2: 9, 10. What has God done for us that we can have these titles, and why has He done it?
- 3. How are you proclaiming God's excellencies in your conduct at church, home, the workplace, and school? Pray for God's strength in being His witness.

Tuesday, 5-7-13 - Reflecting on this Past Sunday

- 1. Read Ephesians 3:10. What do you see happening through the church?
- 2. Read Hebrews 10:24, 25. What do you see happening in the church?
- 3. How should we be involved in the church to see these two things lived out?
- 4. Pray that God would be glorified and our love for each other would grow.

Wednesday, 5-8-13 - Reflecting on this Past Sunday

- 1. Read Romans 5:3-5. When was the last time you rejoiced in your suffering for Christ? What benefits do you see here from suffering? Discuss how each of these benefits would enhance your walk with Christ.
- 2. Pray that God would give us a desire to suffer for the Gospel.

Thursday, 5-9-13 – Preparing for this Sunday

- 1. Read Luke 18:18-30. Sermon title: Is Jesus Enough?
- 2. What did the man ask for, and what was his attitude about salvation? (18)
- 3. Describe Jesus' response in verse 19.
- 4. What did Jesus point to concerning salvation in verse 20? Why? (see James 2:10)
- 5. Read verse 21. What did the man believe, and why is that a problem?
- 6. Pray for God to expose any righteousness in our own hearts absent of God's grace.

Friday, 5-10-13 – Preparing Ourselves for this Sunday

- 1. Read Luke 18:18-30.
- 2. What had a hold of this man's heart? (23)
- 3. Spend some time praying, and ask God to reveal what you are having a difficult time surrendering to Him? (possessions, diet drinks, food, approval, moodiness, jealousy, anger and/or wounds, etc.) Ask God to set you free of loving anything/anyone that has control of your heart.

Saturday, 5-11-13 – Preparing for Tomorrow

- 1. Read Luke 18:18-30.
- 2. Focus on verse 27 for today in order to prepare for tomorrow.
- 3. What does this verse teach us about salvation?
- 4. Pray for someone you know who needs Christ to break through his/her self-righteousness and pride.
