- I. No marriage in heaven
 - 1. We are engaged to Him
- 2 Corinthians 11:12 ...I betrothed you to one husband, so that to Christ I might present you as a pure virgin.
 - 2. Marriage points to a greater reality
- Ephesians 5:31-32 For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and shall be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh. This mystery is great; but I am speaking with reference to Christ and the church.
 - 3. Spouses are better off with Him

Romans 3:28 - For we maintain that a man is justified by faith apart from works of the Law.

Ephesians 2:8-9 - For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.

- 1 Corinthians 1:27-31 God has chosen the foolish of the world to shame the wise, and God has chosen the weak of the world to shame the things which are strong...
 - and the base of the world and the despised God has chosen,
 - the (ones) that are not, so that He may nullify the (ones) that are...
- 29 so that no man may boast before God...
- 30-31 But by His doing you are in Christ Jesus... so that, just as it is written, "Let him who boasts, boast in the Lord."

- Hebrews 1:14 Are (Angels) not all ministering spirits sent out to serve for the sake of those who are to inherit salvation?
- 1 Corinthians 6:2-3 Or do you not know that the saints will judge the world ... Do you not know that we are to judge angels? ...
- 2 Timothy 2:11-12 The saying is trustworthy, for: If we have died with him, we will also live with him; if we endure, we will also reign with him
