- I. Traits that derail true greatness:
 - 1. Pride/selfishness
 - 2. Unresolved hurts/anger
 - 3. Shame and guilt
 - 4. <u>Fear</u>
- II. Truths concerning kingdom greatness:
 - 1. We all secretly desire at times for someone to <u>notice our</u> <u>service</u>.
 - 2. We all are influenced by wrong <u>definitions of greatness</u>.
 - 3. Jesus said we <u>descend into greatness</u>.
 - 4. Leadership and greatness are not about how many people are "under us", but instead about how many people we are serving and <u>strengthening in Christ</u>.
 - 5. Greatness often is enhanced after failure because truly great people are those who have been <u>broken</u>.
 - 6. Great influencers are empowered by the <u>Holy Spirit</u>.
 - 7. Greatness in impacting others is fueled and nourished by walking in God's truth concerning our <u>identity and purpose</u>.
