A feeling of reverence, awe, and respect, **or** an unpleasant emotion caused by a sense of danger. ~ Nelson's Bible Dictionary

TWO KINDS OF FEAR

HEALTHY FEAR

A feeling of reverence, awe and respect.

UNHEALTHY FEAR

An unpleasant emotion caused by a sense of danger.

Fear is a natural consequence of sin.
