I. Four General Truths

II. Characteristics of the Unbelieving:

1. Spiritually poor

Jesus said, Because you say, "I am rich, and have become wealthy, and have need of nothing," and you do not know that you are wretched and miserable and poor and blind and naked. Revelation 3:17

(The unbelieving) are darkened in their understanding, excluded from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the hardness of their heart.

Ephesians 4:18

2. Spiritually enslaved

"This is the judgment, that the Light has come into the world, and men **loved** the darkness rather than the Light, for their deeds were evil.

John 3:19

3. Spiritually blind

4. Spiritually oppressed

- 7. What was Jesus' custom on the Sabbath and what does this say to us about meeting with God's people? (16)
- 8. Summarize what happened once Jesus entered the synagogue? (4:16-30)
- 9. What behaviors reveal that the Spirit of the Lord is working in a person? (18-19)
- 10. What reasons would you list as to why so many believers never introduce another person to know Christ? (think and pray through this one)

- 1. Review Sunday's message with someone.
- 2. Read Ephesians 1:15-23 and 4:15–16. What is the church (God's set apart people) to be in this world?
- 3. What is God's plan of reaching the nations that they would know and love Him the way we do? How are you part of that plan? John 20:21
