1. He Chose His disciples after <u>listening to the Father</u>.

"You did not choose Me but I chose you, and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit..." John 15:16

"No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up on the last day." John 6:44

2. He <u>wanted</u> His disciples to be His.

"Just as the Father has loved Me, I have also loved you; abide in My love." John 15:9

"The Lord your God is in your midst, A victorious warrior. He will exult over you with joy, He will be quiet in His love, He will rejoice over you with shouts of joy." Zephaniah 3:17

"The wind blows where it wishes and you hear the sound of it, but do not know where it comes from and where it is going; so is everyone who is born of the Spirit." John 3:8

- 3. He planned that the key to "discipleship" would be that His disciples would <u>walk with Him</u>.

"A student is not above his teacher; but everyone, after he has been fully trained, will be like his teacher." Luke 6:40 4. He commissioned His disciples to <u>Kingdom ministry</u>, not to create big churches.
