- I. Generous Kingdom giving is to be <u>motivated by grace</u>.
- II. Generous Kingdom giving is often in spite of <u>severe circumstances</u>.
- III. Generous Kingdom giving enhances & completes our joy.
- IV. Generous Kingdom giving is to be willful, not coerced & <u>according to our</u> <u>ability</u>.
- V. Generous Kingdom giving is a decision to participate in the building up of God's people & therefore will <u>often be sacrificial</u>.
- VI. Generous Kingdom giving comes after we are submitted to God & <u>His</u> <u>purposes</u>.
