I. The Problem of a Heart Engraved with Sin. (Jeremiah 17:1-10)

Acts 26:18 - "I am sending you to <u>open their eyes</u> & to turn them from <u>darkness to light</u>...from the <u>power of Satan to God</u>...to <u>faith in me.</u>"

- II. The Promise of a Heart changed by the LORD. (Jeremiah 31:31-33)
 - 1. We now are indwelt by the Spirit.
- 2 Corinthians 3:3 "It is clear that you are a letter from Christ, the result of our ministry, written with... the Spirit of the living God, not on tablets of stone but on tablets of human hearts."
 - 2. We now intimately know Him.
 - 3. We now consume His word.

Jeremiah 15:16 - "Your words were found, and <u>I ate them</u>, and your words became to me a joy and the delight of my heart, for I am called by your name, O LORD, God of hosts."

4. We now boast about Him.

Jeremiah 9:24 - "...<u>let him who boasts boast of this, that he understands and knows Me,</u> that I am the Lord..."

5. We now minister to the needy.

Jeremiah 22:16 - "He pled the <u>cause of the afflicted and needy</u>... 'Is not that what it means to know Me?' Declares the Lord."

6. We now have His joy.

Jeremiah 31:11,14 - "The Lord has ransomed Jacob...They will...<u>shout for joy...</u> My people will be satisfied..."

7. We now depend on Him.

Jeremiah 33:3 - "Call to me and I will answer you, and will tell you great and hidden things that you have not known."

John 15:4 (ESV) - "Abide in me, and I in you."
