The Rescue Begins: The One Who Rescues Matthew 1:1-17

Zephaniah 3:20 - "... I will make you a name and a praise among all people of the earth..."

I. Jesus is the New Adam that brings <u>Life to the nations</u>. (Matthew 1:1-2)

Genesis 5:1 - "This is the book of the <u>generations of Adam</u>. When God created man, he made him in the likeness of God."

Genesis 5:3 – "When <u>Adam</u> had lived 130 years, <u>he fathered a son in</u> <u>his own likeness</u>, <u>after his image</u>, and named him Seth."

Genesis 5:8 – "Thus all the days of Seth were 912 years, and he died."

Genesis 5:11 – "Thus all the days of Enosh were 905 years, and he died."

Genesis 5:14: - "Thus all the days of Kenan were 910 years, <u>and he died</u>."

Genesis 5:24 - <u>"Enoch walked with God</u>, and <u>he was not</u>, for <u>God took him</u>.

- 1 Corinthians 15:45 "Thus it is written, 'The <u>first man Adam became a living being"</u>; the <u>last Adam became a life-giving spirit</u>.""
- 1 Corinthians 15:47 "The first man was <u>from the earth</u>, a man of dust; the second man is <u>from heaven</u>."

II. Jesus is the Son of David who Reigns over the nations. (Matthew 1:1-2)

Matthew 22:41-45

Revelation 22:16 - "I, Jesus, have sent my angel to testify to you about these things for the churches. I am the root and the descendant of <u>David</u>, the <u>bright morning star</u>."

III. Jesus is the Son of Abraham who brings <u>Blessing to the</u> <u>nations.</u> (Matthew 1:1-2)

Genesis 12:1-3 - "Now the Lord said to Abram... 'I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing... and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."
